

## Review present simple vs continuous

Vamos a recordar las principales diferencias entre **present simple** y **present** continuous:

Present simple	Present continuous
Things that are always true:	Things which are happening at the moment of speaking:
• Water boils at 100 degrees.	• The water is boiling now, so you can put in the pasta.
Permanent situations (or nearly permanent; true for a few years at least): • Julie lives in London.	<ul> <li>Temporary situations:</li> <li>Julie is living in Paris for a few months (usually she lives in London). Situations which are slowly changing:</li> <li>I'm getting better and better at speaking English.</li> </ul>
<ul><li>Habits or things we do regularly:</li><li>I drink coffee every morning.</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Temporary or new habits:</li> <li>I'm drinking too much coffee these days because I'm so busy at work. Annoying habits (usually with 'always'):</li> <li>My flat mate is always leaving the kitchen in a mess!</li> </ul>
